Call for Papers

Hello everybody,

We are hard at work preparing the 2004 Digital Fine Art Photographers Summit. I know that many of you are eagerly awaiting the announcement for this year's Summit. Rightly so as we have a lot of exciting new features in the works for the 2004 Summit!

Among these is the opportunity for you to give a presentation on the topic of your choice at this year's Summit and be one of the featured guest speakers.

Guest speaker presentations will be held Sunday, November 14th. We are now accepting abstracts for consideration in this part of our Summit program.

Below are the guidelines you need to follow in order to first submit your presentation proposal and second be considered for review by the Summit guest presentation review panel. The review panel consists of Uwe Steinmueller, Alain Briot and Jim Collum.

1- Abstract

The first thing for you to do if you are interested in being considered as guest speaker at the 2004 Digital Fine Art Photographers Summit is send an abstract, in Word or pdf format, for our review. This abstract needs to contain the following;

- The title of your presentation (about 20 minutes long)
- A one page description of your presentation

- A resume showing your experience in photography and digital imaging

2- Presentation length.

Your presentation needs to be 20 minutes long maximum.

3- Audio and video equipment

A table, lectern, microphone and LCD projector will be available for your use. You will need to bring your own laptop computer. We strongly recommend you use presentation software (such as Microsoft Power Point or Apple Keynote) as visual aid during your presentation. Both PC and Macintosh platforms will be supported

4- The review process

We will acknowledge receipt of your submission the day we receive it. After the review process is completed we will inform you personally of our decision. If your presentation is accepted you will need to forward a complete outline of your presentation, either as a text document or a Powerpoint or Keynote file, within three weeks. This outline needs to be similar to the outline you will use during your Guest Speaker presentation during the 2004 Summit
